

KEY FACTS TUBERCULOSIS SWITZERLAND 2022

Even though there are few cases of tuberculosis in Switzerland per year compared to the rest of the world, correct detection, treatment and prevention are important public health measures.



354 REPORTED
CASES

In 2022, 354 TB cases were reported to the FOPH. This means 1% less than in the previous year.

199
CONTACT INVESTIGATIONS
have been carried out



1823 contacts were tested, 246 of them are considered to be infected.



TST VS. IGRA

95.2% of all tested people were tested only with an IGRA, 4.8% with a TST.



In 75% of all contact investigations, not more than **10 PEOPLE** were tested.

PREVENTATIVE TBI THERAPIES



59% of all infected contacts started with a TBI THERAPY, 55% of them completed their therapy **SUCCESSFULLY**.

CHARACTERISTICS OF TB CASES



75% of all TB cases are pulmonary, 26% exclusively extrapulmonary.

The majority of index patients are between 20 and 50 years old.

COSTS AND REVENUES

The full costs for the cantonal TB work amounted to CHF 750'000. 93% were covered by cantonal service contracts.



A total of 136 DOT were carried out, which equals 39% of all cases.
